

PERMANENT LIP COLOR HEALING STAGES

DAYS 1-2



Lips will have a thick reddish brick color with tenderness and swelling. You may taste a metallic flavor in your mouth.

DAY 3



Lips will be sore but have less swelling, thicker texture and a hot feeling before exfoliation with an orange color.

DAY 4



Signs of exfoliation will begin to show. Lips will be very chapped. Do not pick.

DAY 5



Chapping stage will still be ongoing. Do not pick.

DAYS 7-14



Color may seem to disappear as the skin heals. The "frosty" chapping stage will begin with a whitish/grayish haze on lips.

DAY 21



Lip healing is complete, with the color you see being the color that you will keep. Lips will remain dry for 1-2 months.

PERMANENT MAKEUP LIP COLOR AFTERCARE TIPS

Apply ice as needed.

Finish taking any prescribed fever blister prevention medication

Keep lips moist with Hustle Butter (HB) Permanent Makeup aftercare balm or Aquaphor healing ointment.

Use balm until the full color is complete.

Take Ibuprofen as needed to help with pain and swelling.
